

Table Tennis Rules

The Controller reserves the right to change any of the draws at any time.
Possible Rule changes will be announced at the start of the Tournament.

All games to be played under the current ITTF International Rules.
3-Star Table Tennis balls will be used.
Points can be stopped if interference occurs from other tables.
If ball hits the roof, it is a point lost.
Table Tennis will be run as an Individual & Doubles Event.

Men's

This will be a round-robin competition in two sections.

Play-off games are played in 5 sets.

The top 2 players in each section will proceed to the Semi Finals

- 1st Section 1 vs 2nd Section 2
- 2nd Section 1 vs 1st Section 2

Semi Finals and Final will be the best of 7 sets.

Winners of the Semi Finals will play the Final for 1st and 2nd place in the overall competition.

Losers of the Semi Finals will play for 3rd and 4th place in the overall competition.

Women's

All players will play each other in a round-robin competition.

Play-off games are played in 5 sets.

A points system will be used to determine the top 4 players

The top 4 players will play Semi Finals:

- 1st vs 3rd place
- 2nd vs 4th place

Semi Finals and Final will be the best of 7 sets.

Winners of the Semi Finals will play a Final to determine 1st and 2nd place in the overall competition.

Losers of the Semi Finals will play for 3rd and 4th place in the overall competition.

Mixed-Table Tennis (Official)

Teams of 2 players (1 male and 1 female)

Event made up of 2 singles matches (male vs male; female vs female) and 1 mixed double match

Best of 3 games in each match

Best of 5 sets in each game

Team with highest score wins the match

Every team will play against all others

Points will be awarded for matches won

The two teams with the most points overall will play a Final match for 1st and 2nd in the overall competition.

The 3rd and 4th teams will play to determine the 3rd place in the overall competition.
